TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Registration opens August 1, 2009
2. Deadline for entry: At blast off morning of the tournament.
3. LAUNCH SEQUENCE WILL BE DETERMINED BY WHEN ENTRY FEE IS RECEIVED.
4. All live wells will be checked prior to tournament. if you haven't been checked see a tournament official before blast off for your catch to count.
5. Scoring: a) A LIMIT OF 5 BASS (largemouth, smallmouth, spotted, or cosa bass) may be weighed in. Any team bringing in more than a 5 bass limit to the scales will lose biggest fish to get down to the legal limit of 5 fish.
b) Minimum length will be twelve inches. Length will be measured on a flat board, mouth closed
c) A short fish brought to the scales will result in a 1 pound penalty.
d) Dead fish will be penalized four ounces. So please use ice and additives.
e) All culling must be done after the fifth fish is caught, never should there be more than five fish in a live-well.
f) Late penalty on one pound per minute up to 15 min. boat must be off plane in sight of the tournament check in point. Which will be marked clearly.
6. all live fish will be released.
7. ONLY artificial baits may be used. All bass must be caught alive in legal sporting manner. No snagging, no trolling, only one rod must be used at a time. When sight fishing, the fish must be hooked inside the mouth to keep.
8. ANCHOR RULE: A team boat sitting with trolling motor up and anchor down, all other team boats must stay at least 50 yards away. No hole-sitting allowed. (meaning: another boat can not save a fishing hole for any team boat.)
9. All teams and their boats must stay in the water at all times during the tournament hours. Except for emergencies or at the direction of the tournament director.
10. In case of breakdowns, one team member may bring back fish in another teams boat.
11. Alcoholic beverages will not be allowed at tournament.
12. Good sportsmanship is expected from all teams at all times. Disorderly conduct will result in disqualification.
13. All complaints or protest should be made to the tournament director within 15 min. of conclusion of the weigh in.
14. ALL DECISIONS BY THE TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS ARE FINAL.
15. LIFE JACKETS MUST BE WORN WHILE GASOLINE ENGINE IS OPERATING. WORKING KILL SWITCH MUST BE ATTACHED WHILE GASOLINE ENGINE IS OPERATING.
16. All teams are to abide by all state rules and regulations.
17. A POLYGRAPH TEST WILL BE GIVEN AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE TOURNAMENT, BEFORE AWARDS ARE GIVEN OUT, FAILURE WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION!!!!!!
